Items	Recommendations
1-2 package pencils	Teachers recommend #2 <i>Ticonderoga</i> Brand
1 hand held pencil sharpener	Needed if student(s) does not have access to a family pencil sharpener
1 package of colored pencils	Teachers recommend <i>Crayola</i> Brand
1 package crayons	Teachers recommend at least 24 pack of <i>Crayola</i> Brand
1 package of 10 count Washable Markers	Teachers recommend <i>Crayola</i> Brand
4-8 glue sticks	Teachers recommend <i>Elmer's</i> brand
1 pair scissors	Teachers recommend by age level: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grades K/1 = 5" blunted scissors</li> <li>• Grades 2-5 = 6" pointed scissors</li> </ul>
1 watercolor paint set with brush	Teachers recommend <i>Crayola</i> Brand
2 bottom pocket folders	
2-3 composition notebooks	5th graders would need 3 composition notebooks (one for math, science, and ELA class)
1 ear bud set or headphones that are compatible with Chromebooks	Will be helpful when students are participating in Zoom calls at home, especially if 2 Chromebooks are in the same room to avoid echoing when on a live Zoom. Headphones with microphones help with students being heard.
3 white board markers	Fox will be sending home a whiteboard and markers for all students, but colors or additional pens will likely be needed. An old sock or tissue works well to erase.
1 pack index cards	Teachers will cue how to use these for flash cards during live sessions.
1 package of lined paper	Recommended for grades 3-5
Ideas for Organization	
1 Pencil Pouch	A ziplock bag can be used as an alternative
1 Plastic Supply Box	A shoe box or other basket from home can work.
1 Backpack	Even at home, zipping up student supplies and papers in their backpacks at the end of the learning day could help keep things organized and teach helpful skills for organizing materials that will transfer to school upon reopening for face-to-face learning.
